ARCTIC WORKS - A NEW MODEL FOR RECRUITMENT IN GREENLAND

Xploration Services Greenland A/S & Icelandic Handafl ehf join forces to establish a Greenlandic recruitment company aimed at the building, construction and the mining industry.

BACKGROUND:

With the increasing activity in the construction industry and with the prospect of imminent success in the mining industry, there is a huge and continued pressure on the labor force in Greenland. Despite massive education and employment measures, there is a need to import labor in order to address both the general construction tasks, but also to solve the major infrastructure projects which are yet to be commenced.

The Xploration Services Greenland A/S (XS) provides solutions as a core business of servicing foreign companies in Greenland (e.g. administration, planning, logistics, catering, camps, accommodation, recruitment ...) and have for the past two years experienced an increasing demand for "recruitment". The demand comes from both the mining sector and the building and construction industry respectively.

XS has extensive experience and success to recruit, educate and train manpower from Greenland, but has limited experience in recruiting internationally.

Handafl ehf has many years of experience in recruiting skilled and unskilled labor for the construction industry in Iceland. Over the past two years Handafl has experienced a growing interest from Greenlandic and international clients on recruitment to the Greenlandic labor market.

The customer pays regular monthly rate, calculated from the employee's scheduled hours. This model ensures that the financial incentive for ARCTIC WORKS is <u>not</u> a quick one-time payment, instead it is in the interest of ARCTIC WORKS to maintain the good relationship between the employee and the enterprise customer. This gives both ARCTIC WORKS and business customers an interest in the employee working on a long-term perspective, with greater likelihood of long-term positions.





The Director of XS and acting manager of ARCTIC WORKS, Mr. Bent Olsvig Jensen, says: As a Greenlandic company it is essential for us to have as many activities and as much income for Greenland as possible.
